Advantages: completeness
 accurate addressing

Disadvantages: cost
 no prior information about postal areas for stratification
 not as useful as ER for sampling individuals

Electoral Registers

Updated annually. Reference date Oct 10. Published Feb. 16. Lists eligible 18+. Divided into constituencies - wards - polling districts. Within these, in address order within street.

Advantages: convenience and availability
 good stratification available for constituencies
 provides estimate of number of adults living there (improves efficiency when sampling adults)

Disadvantages: incompleteness. When published, about 6% are not registered at their current address (rising to 16% by the time the next register is published). But if used as a frame of addresses, deficiency is only about 4%. Some groups less well represented than others.
